- **Predestination** – (*I have a predetermined destination*) – Romans 8:29
- **Conformity** (*my life is to mirror the life of Jesus*) – Romans 8:29



Where does trauma happen?

Trauma is stored in your (**SOUL**)...



Mind – heart, seat of my emotions

Transformation changes

1. Devotion
2. Consecration
3. Sacrifice
4. Conformity
5. Mind renewal



1. **Devotion** - *faithfulness to something to which one is bound by pledge or duty*

2. **Consecration** - *The act of dedicating yourself to the service and worship of God*

3.

Sacrifice - *giving to the Lord whatever He requires of our time, our earthly possessions, and our energies to further His work.*

4. **Conformity** - *an inner change of nature, working into the outward life*

5. **Mind renewal** - *interpreting life through the lens of God's Word and the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, rather than through the lens of your experience, woundedness, trauma, preferences, or the opinions of others*



How Do I Know I am Transformed

1. Conformity to the Image of Christ (*Galatians 4:19*)

2. Knowledge of the Principles, Laws and Mysteries of the Kingdom

- *Promises* – God’s commitment to the believer
- *Principles* – secrets of the kingdom
- *Prophecies* – revealed to give me hope of the end.

3. Power and ability of God (*Acts 1:8*)

4. Fruits of the Spirit (*Galatians 5:22*)
